Triad is a national, state, and local program focused on reducing crimes against seniors through crime prevention education. In Virginia, the Office of the Attorney General (OAG) sponsors all Triad organizations.

History

In 2016, the Chickahominy Area Triad resulted from a partnership between the OAG, Charles City County Sheriff and New Kent County Sheriff Offices, Charles City and New Kent governmental departments, human service agencies, civic groups, and community seniors.



Members of this partnership agreed to work collectively to establish and implement a crime prevention program that would continually educate and provide seniors with the tools and services needed to prevent them from becoming the victims of crimes and to improve their quality of life.

Overview

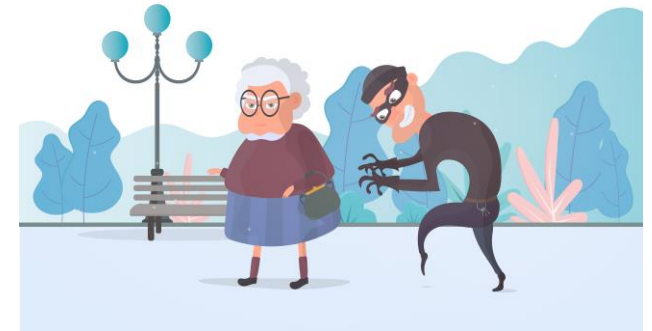
The efforts of the partners (local sheriff departments, community seniors, and social service agencies) working together to help reduce the criminal victimization of the elderly. Important to the organization is its Advisory Council, which consists of law enforcement leaders, local governmental agencies, businesses, and community seniors. They serve as a sounding board and catalyst for monitoring and keeping the focus and emphasis on reducing crimes against the elderly and with identifying beneficial safeguards and resources that will protect our aging population.

The Triad’s primary mission is to help our senior population and the communities in general, stay one-step ahead of scammers, and their fraudulent activities through our continuous education and awareness efforts.



Statistical Data

Older Americans make up the fastest-growing segment of the population. By 2025, 25% of Virginia’s population will be age 60 and up. This statistic will continue to rise and criminals will continue preying on older Americans, as Triad’s work to prevent and/or stop the exploitation of our senior population.



Programs, Services & Activities

Spring & Fall Events – Senior health, safety, and fellowship events are held to educate our seniors and have a little fun.

Active Aging Week Event – Held in September to celebrate active aging.

“Not Forgotten” Wellness Calls -- This program was established to assist citizens who need daily contact. Plus, to checks on community senior citizens three times a week either by phone or in person.

Triad Fundraising Events. These events are held throughout the year. Funds raised are used to host future senior fellowship gatherings.

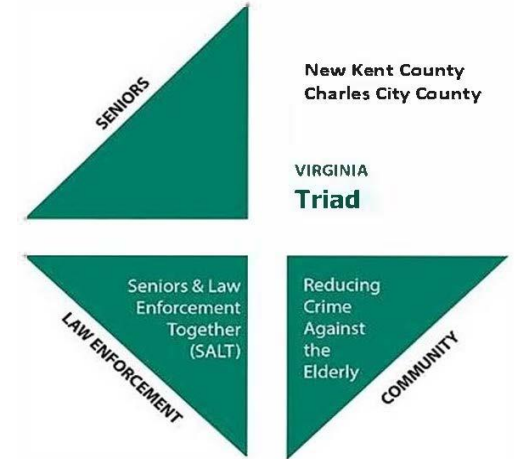
